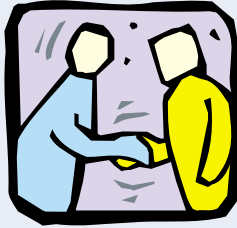

**Matching Gift** programs, where they will match or multiply a gift up to a

certain amount. **Gifts of Marketable Securities** provide donors with a charitable deduction for the fair market value of the security, and when appreciated, a capital gains tax savings. A gift of **Real Estate** allows a donor to receive an income tax deduction based on the full market value of

the gift, secure capital gains tax savings, and avoid certain costs associated with the transfer of real estate.

Building an **Endowment** is critical to Foothill Family's longevity and its ability to continue to provide services that will secure the futures of the



children and families in our communities. You can help us build this endowment and participate in a lasting community legacy.

In 2001, Foothill Family Service was chosen by the California Community Foundation as an Endowment Partner. This partnership will yield a higher return in investment to both Foothill Family and its planned giving donors with access to the Community Foundation's gift planning resources and the security of a large pool of professionally managed endowment funds through the Community Foundation's money managers. This will



enable Foothill Family to build its endowment with minimal administrative costs, without incurring fundraising or legal costs while its internal resources are used to continue to provide direct services to our clients.



**Planned Gifts** can be made by leaving a gift to Foothill Family Service in a will, or can be a charitable gift arrangement with tax and income benefits. **Complex gifts** such as real estate and closely held business interests can be facilitated through the Foothill Family Service Endowment at the California Community Foundation. The Community Foundation can act as trustee for charitable remainder and lead trusts.

Lastly, we are able to offer **charitable gift annuities** through the Community Foundation's Community Life Annuity Service. With a gift annuity, you receive a lifetime income of a percentage of the gift, depending on your age. The remainders of charitable gift annuities are placed in our designated endowment fund benefiting Foothill Family in perpetuity.

Any gift can be designated to **Foothill Family's Vision Fund**, a reserve fund used by Foothill Family to: develop, implement and strengthen programs; maintain its facilities in Pasadena and El Monte; purchase furniture and equipment; and provide for the continued direct services to our communities' children and families.
