We are committed to improving infant, child, youth, and family development, resulting in success in relationships, school, and work.

For nearly 95 years, Foothill Family has led the way in providing comprehensive mental health and social services throughout the San Gabriel and Pomona Valleys, Glendale, and Burbank, through the following key programmatic areas:



Mental Health Care

Foothill Family provides effective mental health assessment and treatment for children and adults, individuals and families.

Early Childhood Development

Foothill Family's zero to five programs provide parents/caregivers and their young, high-needs children with essential early intervention, detection, and prevention strategies and tools during their child's critical developmental years. Services include parent education and can address autism spectrum disorder and/or other developmental delays.

School-Based Services

Currently providing services in 18 school districts in Southern California, Foothill Family provides assistance to children and youth exhibiting social and/or emotional challenges in order for them to succeed at school, at home, and in their communities. Our programs include teacher trainings and promote school community development alongside school/family engagement.

Youth & Family Services

Foothill Family launches families on healthy journeys by providing mental health treatment for children and their caregivers, as well as treatment and support services for victims of abuse, neglect, and/or domestic violence. Also, case management and mentoring programs help pregnant and/or parenting youth to attend school and graduate, raise healthy babies, and learn positive parenting skills.





