



Dear Friends,

The success of Foothill Family's 2021-2022 fiscal year brought about program expansion, family center enhancements and openings, as well as new employee positions that signify meaningful growth and development in the services we so proudly provide for our children and families.

Since 1926, Foothill Family has been reaching the youngest and most vulnerable populations to give every child the opportunity to grow and thrive in an environment where they are healthy, nurtured and loved. These past few years have weighed heavily on many families' mental wellness. The prolonged effect of the past few years is beginning to surface and the need for our services has increased exponentially. In 2022, there was a 40% increase in referrals over 2021 with our intake team answering over 7,000 inquiry calls. The need is staggering.

Foothill Family's staff continue to do a remarkable job adapting how they provide services to further reach out within our communities to provide support for children and families in these times of strain and uncertainty. They are our front lines, and the reason for the reputation Foothill Family has earned as a leader in mental health care and early childhood development program delivery. The team has worked tirelessly in helping nearly 24,000 parents and children thrive, together this past year alone.

Through the Planting Deeper Roots campaign, we undertook an ambitious endeavor and purchased a 10,000 sq. ft. building in Pomona. We are humbled by the immense outpouring of support. To date, we have raised 97% of the \$4.0M goal and we are currently making improvements to the building. The programs are geared toward serving women and children ages 0-3, two of the highest under-served populations in Pomona. Our focus on prevention and intervention supports children's development and promotes resilience as well as supports single mothers and families affected by domestic violence.

The commitment of our Board of Directors, our Advisory Board, and our volunteer group, the Friends of Foothill Family, add markedly to help advance Foothill Family's mission and provide the community leadership that is essential to our impact and future growth. The advances we have achieved at Foothill Family would not be possible without the advocacy of these crucial champions, as well as the strategic partnerships we have established with our generous individual, corporate, and foundation donors.

This annual report acknowledges you – our supporters who help our community heal and thrive. Your generosity strengthened families and enriched communities. Thank you for your investment in the kids and families Foothill Family continues to serve!

Since 1926, Foothill Family has led the way in providing comprehensive mental health and social services throughout the San Gabriel and Pomona Valleys, Glendale, and Burbank, through the following key programmatic areas:



Mental Health Care

Foothill Family provides effective mental health assessment and treatment for children and adults, individuals and families.

Early Childhood Development

Foothill Family's zero to five programs provide parents/caregivers and their young, high-needs children with essential early intervention, detection, and prevention strategies and tools during their child's critical developmental years. Services include parent education and can address autism spectrum disorder and/or other developmental delays.

School-Based Services

Currently providing services in 18 school districts in Southern California,
Foothill Family provides assistance to children and youth exhibiting social and/or emotional challenges in order for them to succeed at school, at home, and in their communities.

Our programs include teacher trainings and promote school community development alongside school/family engagement.

Youth & Family Services

Foothill Family launches families on healthy journeys by providing mental health treatment for children and their caregivers, as well as treatment and support services for victims of abuse, neglect, and/or domestic violence. Also, case management and mentoring programs help pregnant and/or parenting youth to attend school and graduate, raise healthy babies, and learn positive parenting skills.


